### Blues Trivia

**Q:** The Blues world recently lost one of its legendary Piedmont Blues guitarists, **Etta Baker**. She died on September 23, 2006 at the age of 93 just months before her final album was to be released. Etta was born on March 31, 1915, in Caldwell County, NC into a musical family and began playing the guitar at the age of 3. Where did she work before she began her professional musical career?

**A:** Etta Baker worked for 26 years at a textile mill in Morganton, NC before quitting at the age of 60 to pursue her musical career. Her 1st full length CD was released in 1991— she was 76 years old.
